Previously, he has managed the regional tourism organisation of South Tyrol in Italy, a destination hosting 6 million tourists per year. Since 2014 he is Adjunct Research Professor at the School of Marketing/Curtin Business School in Perth/WA. Furthermore, he is President **AIEST** of the (Association Internationale d'Experts Scientifiques Tourisme). Since 2016, Harald Pechlaner is a full member of the European Academy of Sciences and Arts.
