

Managing Tourism Flows and Quality of Life

Visiting academic Oswin Maurer will present the findings of his investigation into the impact of tourism flows on life satisfaction of Berlin residents, using data from the DIW (German **Economic** Research Institute in Berlin). empirical analysis based on panel data of 8,439 individuals over a 12-year period employs a bottom-up spillover model of tourism impact on residents' satisfaction with life, and provides theoretical and practical insights and findings.

Oswin Maurer is Dean and Professor of Marketing, Faculty of Economics and Management, Free University of Bozen-Bolzano (Italy). Before joining unibz, he held professorial and executive positions at universities in Germany, Denmark, New Zealand and Australia. He is a Director of the Board of THE-ICE, Brisbane, and Eminent Professor at William Angliss Institute, Melbourne. Oswin still spends considerable time in Australia, collaborating with universities and a variety of industries.
